# HSRC-A1AA-McLean-MGC-RCV What are these groups?

It is really confusing about which organization does what, so maybe the following will help.

Fortuna Senior Center—membership-based nonprofit which provides programs & activities and information about services for seniors.

Area 1 Agency on Aging (A1AA) - there are 33 areas in California; Area 1 represents Humboldt and Del Norte. It receives state and federal funds for Senior Information & Assistance, Senior Legal Services, Long Term Care Ombudsman, Nutrition—Dining Centers & Home-Delivered Meals, Health Insurance Counseling (HICAP). Area 1 also manages the Volunteer Driver Program. A1AA is the best resource for everything senior.

Humboldt Senior Resource Center (HSRC) - it provides programs for seniors in Eureka but also receives funds from A1AA for the Dining Centers & Home-Delivered Meals. It receives funding to operate the Alzheimer's Resource Center, Adult Day Health, and PACE (Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly), and it manages the firewood program as a fundraiser.

McLean Foundation—is a privately-funded foundation that provides funding for nonprofit organizations in the northern Humboldt area.

MGC—is now under the McLean Foundation and will continue to do programs for youth, families, and the community.

Redwood Coast Village (RCV) - is a nonprofit that provides volunteer-based services for its senior members—transportation, helping hands, checkingin phone calls.
